IATP Congratulates Abbott Northwestern on Healthy Food Initiative Minneapolis Hospital Launches Farmers Market, CSA Drop Site and Expands Local Purchasing

Minneapolis – A new healthy food initiative launched by Abbott Northwestern Hospital, the largest hospital in the Twin Cities, is part of a growing trend to bring healthy, local food to health care. Abbott Northwestern has launched a new "mini" farmers market and has become a Community Supported Agriculture drop site. It is also working with its food service management company, Morrison Healthcare Food Services, to expand the availability of fresh, locally grown food in its hospital operations.

"In the health care world, we are seeing a growing desire to increase use of healthy, locally produced foods," said JoAnne Berkenkamp of the Institute for Agriculture and Trade Policy (IATP). "IATP is delighted to partner with Abbott Northwestern in their efforts here in Minnesota. Abbott Northwestern's new initiatives show how a variety of approaches can be used to make healthier, local food more accessible to hospital staff, patients, visitors and neighborhood residents alike."

Abbott Northwestern's new farmers market runs on Thursdays from 12 - 4 p.m., from July 9 through September 24. The hospital also partners with two local farms—Foxtail Farm and Burning River Farm—that deliver fresh produce to 26 staff employees each week.

"Abbott Northwestern is committed to improving the health of our community, and eating fresh fruits and vegetables is important for good health," said Ellie Zuehlke, director of Community Benefit for Allina Hospitals & Clinics. "We are proud to be working with community partners to offer more healthy foods as part of Allina's broader healthy food initiative."

Morrison Healthcare Food Services, part of Compass Group, one of the nation's largest food service management companies, is coordinating efforts to supply Abbott Northwestern with more locally grown food.

Across the country, Morrison is part of Compass' initiative to develop purchasing relationships with 2,013 American family farms by the 2013. In partnership with IATP, Compass' "Ag in the Middle" initiative is making fresh food from mid-sized farms available at hundreds of health care sites, colleges, K-12 schools and businesses.
