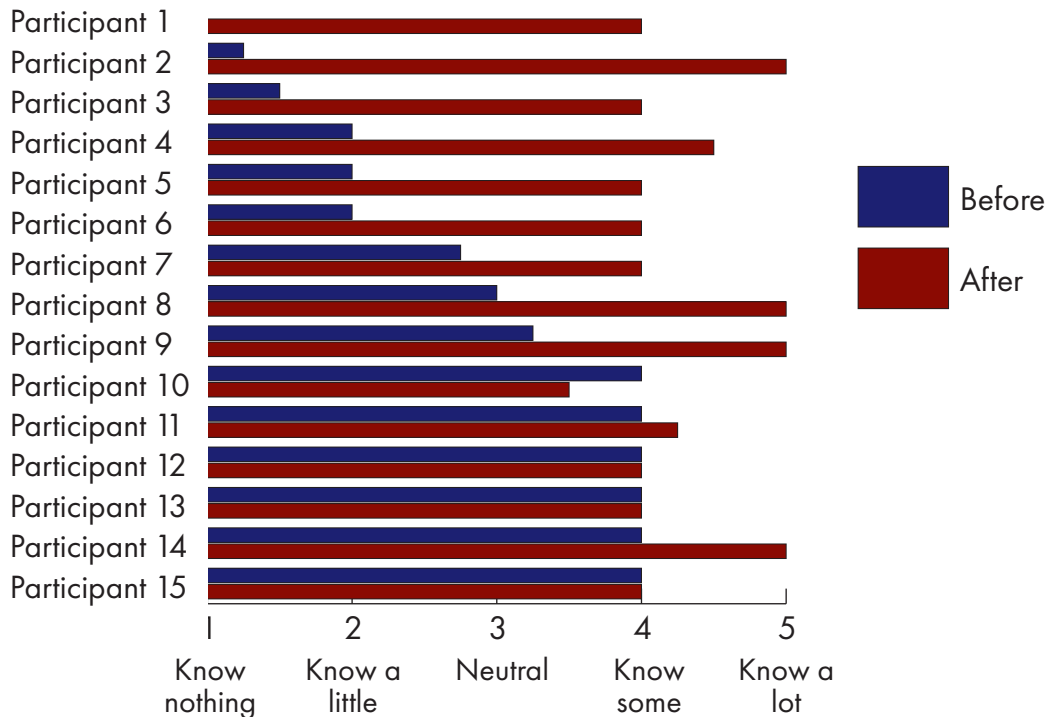


# PANELIST EVALUATION

How much would you say you know about the changes in the number of extreme weather events and shifts in climate patterns and how these changes will affect the Morris area?



Survey responses before and after the Morris Area Climate Dialogue. Chart data reflect each participant's average answer on a scale of 1-5 for four questions related to perceived knowledge.

## BEFORE

**27%** say that increases in extreme weather and major shifts in climate patterns in Morris are "extremely likely."

**2/15** participants strongly agreed that there were actions they can take to address risks associated with extreme weather and shifting climate patterns.

**7/15** participants were willing or very willing to talk with their neighbors about the risks of extreme weather and shifting climate patterns.

**14/15** participants agreed Morris area community members and local, county, and state governments should take action to address the risks created by extreme weather and shifting climate patterns.

**9/15** participants agreed to share their contact information with local groups working to address the risks created by extreme weather and shifting climate patterns.

## AFTER

**54%** say that increases in extreme weather and major shifts in climate patterns in Morris are "extremely likely."

**7/15** participants strongly agreed that there were actions they can take to address risks associated with extreme weather and shifting climate patterns.

**13/15** participants were willing or very willing to talk with their neighbors about the risks of extreme weather and shifting climate patterns.
