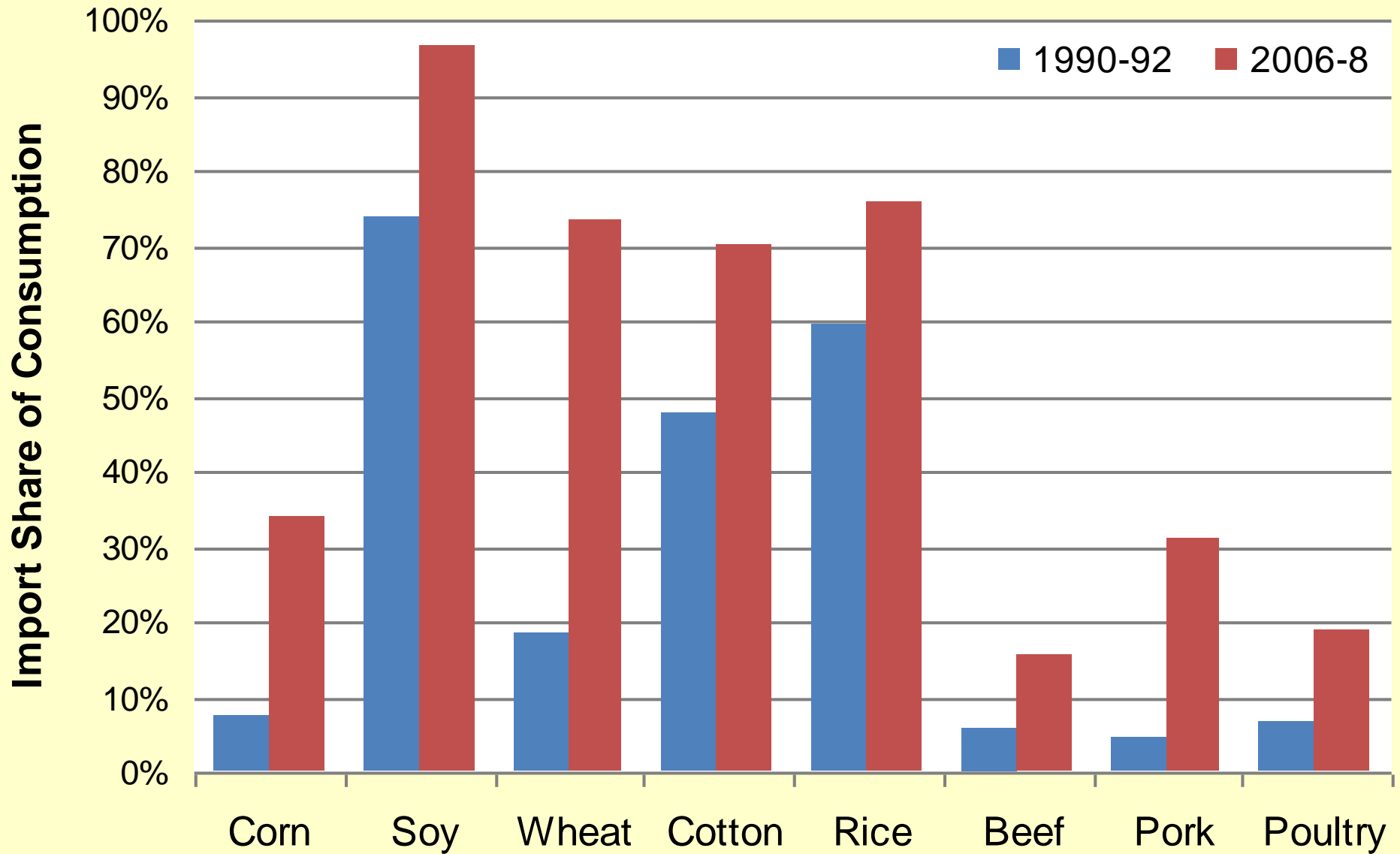


# Mexico: Rising Import Dependency
